

is a first step for women facing an unplanned pregnancy. They welcome women with unconditional love, counsel and resources, while providing support for both mothers and babies. Your present will help these families adjust to a new life together.

- INNER CITY IMPACT uses after-school programs, camps, mentorships and leadership development to disciple children, build healthy relationships and teach vital life skills. Your present will bless a child at the Cicero or Logan Square locations.
- LOVE INC partners with many local churches to unify the Body of Christ around meeting the physical and spiritual needs of our neighbors. Your present will support their Toy Express Christmas store serving DuPage County families in need.

- outreach seeks to transform lives and communities through children's programming, counseling and by connecting under-resourced community members with vital resources. Your present will be featured in Outreach's Christmas store, which offers gifts at prices that are accessible for every income level.
- THE SALVATION ARMY is motivated by the love of God to preach the Gospel and meet human needs in Jesus' name without discrimination. Your gift will empower families to give their children presents from the Salvation Army Christmas store.





Uplift Vulnerable Children

Jesus advocated for women, children and those with disabilities in a time when few did. As Christ followers, we support partners who work to protect kids from abuse; ensure they are adequately fed, clothed and cared for: and provide them with the spiritual and academic nurture that increases their health and hope, and draws them closer to God.

■ JILL + PHILIP ASPEGREN

founded Casa Viva Costa Rica to provide a safe place for children when they become separated from their families. Local community members provide small, secure and specific solutions for children in need.

- \$7 covers the cost of a safe night's sleep for a child.
- with Allinta Ruwana to provide vital healthcare services for about 1,000 children who come from some of the most vulnerable families in Potosí, a mountainous mining town in Bolivia. Allinta Ruwana provides glasses to many families that are unable to purchase them.
- \$40 covers the cost of a medical exam and glasses for kids in Bolivia.





- **RESILIENT** offers opportunities for youth to overcome challenges and reach a new level of flourishing. Resilient's Upstart Program prepares youth to seek rewarding, life-long careers in the construction trades. Their biblical approach to life skills and technical development provides local non-college-bound students a great start to a life of sustainable employment.
- \$25 covers the cost of the entrance exam for a construction apprenticeship program.

■ SOUTH ASIAN FRIENDSHIP

CENTER shares Christ in Chicago's Little India, a diverse neighborhood representing Hindus, Muslims, Sikhs, Jews, Christians and more. They show Christ's love through tutoring, English classes and kids' activities while providing free resources for those exploring faith.

\$25 provides a month's supply of diapers for a family.

■ LESLIE + VIC TRAUTWEIN

work with Kids Alive International in the Dominican Republic to lift children spiritually, emotionally, mentally and physically. Most of the 1,900 students in seven Kids Alive schools live in impoverished conditions and can't afford essential dental care.

\$10 covers the cost of bi-annual preventive dental care.





Relieve Hunger

It's estimated that

20% of families in Chicagoland & Of families worldwide face food insecurity.

Jesus met the physical needs of those who were suffering and lacked resources. It is because of God's grace that we are moved to offer relief to people who are experiencing hunger, food insecurity or the inability to feed their families.

ATUL + SUMAN AGHAMKAR

serve with the National Center for Urban Transformation (NCUT) and the Urban Alliance Center (UAC) in Bangalore, India. NCUT mobilizes and equips Christian leaders through training seminars, conferences, writers' workshops and publications. The UAC serves vulnerable populations, including widows who struggle to survive within the hierarchical society.

- \$25 provides a month's supply of food for a widow.
- BREAKTHROUGH partners with community members in the East Garfield Park neighborhood to build connections, develop skills and open doors of opportunity. They provide breakfast, lunch and dinner to individuals experiencing homelessness 365 days a year.
- **\$25** provides one day of food for an individual.



- The LIFT MARKET is a grocery store-style food pantry that provides food and essential items to local families in need. It is one of many services of the LIFT Center that seeks to meet the physical and spiritual needs of those in our community, help people in crisis achieve independence and connect people with local resources.
- \$15 provides milk, eggs, meat, cheese, bread and a bag of fresh produce to help a family in need.
- WORLD RELIEF DUPAGE/

AURORA works to create welcoming communities where refugees and immigrants thrive. In partnership with the local church, World Relief envisions the most vulnerable people transformed economically, socially and spiritually.

\$35 provides groceries to help feed a local refugee family.





Support Anti-Trafficking Work

It's estimated that more than million people are currently trapped in modern-day slavery.

Exploitation exists when people in power prey on the vulnerabilities that poverty creates. That's why we support partners who protect people from abuse, work against unjust systems and provide holistic care to survivors.

- exploitation and empower male trafficking survivors to rebuild their lives and offer the hope of the Gospel. Their Journey to Healing program helps men escape commercial exploitation through faith-based support.
- \$35 provides materials needed for Emmaus' life skills classes and spiritual enrichment programs.





- **INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE**
- MISSION partners with local communities to bring freedom, justice and lasting safety to some of the world's most vulnerable people. They organize rescue operations, provide survivors with aftercare, work to hold perpetrators accountable through the justice system, and train local law enforcement to protect vulnerable people in their areas.
- \$30 contributes to the cost of rescuing an individual who is being trafficked.
- RECLAIM13's mission is to restore and redeem the lives of children impacted by sexual abuse and sex trafficking. Reclaim13 uses gift cards not only for their mentor program, but also in care bags distributed to recovered children/women during FBI stings.
- \$35 provides food for a girl or woman escaping trafficking and abuse.

- SET CAPTIVES FREE is a local initiative in the Middle East that supports victims of human trafficking. Their programs focus on direct victim assistance, community prevention work, repatriation and sustainable survivor care support.
- \$15 provides a survivor with a one month stay in an emergency shelter.





Provide Bibles & Discipleship Tools

It is estimated that

1.5 billion people
do not have a
fully translated Bible in their
own language. That's why
we are passionate about
supporting partners who
make disciples in all nations
and bring the Scriptures and
Bible study resources to new
believers everywhere.

- with Global Fellowship to make disciples and plant new churches by empowering local leaders and cross-cultural missionaries to pioneer church-planting work among unreached people. Their vision is to plant a Gospel witness within 30 minutes of all people.
- \$5 provides a Bible for a believer in India.
- PROJECT VIDEO helps unique cultures and communities create films in their own language, reaching places evangelists cannot. Portable Gospel Players share testimonies, worship and teaching in any language for groups lacking internet access or the ability to read and write.
- \$25 provides one audio Gospel player.





- JOSÉ PABLO SANCHEZ works with Decisión Spain to disciple Spanish youth and incarcerated people through training and counseling courses. Through their efforts, many inmates were introduced to Christ and are growing in their faith.
- \$15 provides discipleship books for women in prison in Spain.
- **TALKING BIBLES**

INTERNATIONAL produces and discreetly shares God's Word in local languages, giving hidden house churches in India safe access to Scripture. Despite persecution and anti-conversion laws, believers can hear the Gospel, transforming lives and strengthening the underground Church.

\$25 gives access to Scripture for 6 people.
