PASTOR PETE IN HIS PAJAMAS

WELCOME: Hey Families, as we settle into a new rhythm for our shelter in place, we are going to be producing a weekly Wednesday family devotional called “Pastor Pete in his Pajamas” We hope that it will be a helpful follow up to our Sunday lessons, and a fun way to connect together!

ACTIVITY SUPPLIES –

- A Sheep (Stuffed, Cotton Ball Creation, Coloring Sheet Etc.)

1.) PRAY – Start by praying together as a family. In your prayer, ask God to give you a repentant heart!

3.) READ – Open your Bibles and read Luke 15:4-7

4.) Discuss – As a family talk through these questions!

- Have you ever been lost?
 - How did you feel?
 - What did you feel like when you were found?
- Think about the Bible story...
 - Why do you think the sheep was lost in the first place?
 - Why did the Shepherd leave all of his sheep to find the one lost sheep?
 - How are we like the lost sheep?
- Think about the boat story?
 - How is a relationship with Jesus like a boat ride?
 - How is sin like jumping off of the boat?
 - Why do so many people try to swim when Jesus is offering them a boat?
- How does it feel to know that no matter what, Jesus will forgive your sin and bring you back on the “boat”
- As a family how can you practice repentance and forgiveness this week?

5.) Pray – Close out your time in prayer together.

6.) LOST SHEEP HIDE AND SEEK

- Grab a sheep, it can be a toy, a stuffed animal or one that you make.
- Take turns hiding your sheep somewhere in the house.
- Take turns finding the lost sheep. (If it’s really hard you can give clues).
- Every time you find the sheep say “Jesus always forgives my sin!”

7.) Pray – Close out your time in prayer together.
